- 2. At the Sign In prompt, enter your IU username followed by @iu.edu (<u>username@iu.edu</u>). Do this no matter what your email address is. Select Next.
- 3. At Enter Password prompt, enter your IU passphrase. Select Sign In
- 4. Complete Duo two factor authentication
- 5. For first time sign in, check and accept terms; select 'Continue to Azure Portal website'
- 6. Select 'Software' in left column menu to view list of available software

- clear the cache, cookies and browsing history
- use Internet Explorer or Microsoft Edge and enable the In-private browsing by pressing CTRL + Shift + P on the Keyboard or, for Chrome CTRL + Shift + N
